

Fibre sourcing policy Domsjö Fiber

Domsjö Fiber AB imposes stringent requirements on the bio raw material purchasing process.

Basic requirements

The current laws and regulations applied by respective countries of origin determine the basic level of environmental requirements.

Domsjö Fiber AB does **not** purchase bio raw material that:


- has been harvested illegally
- derives from genetically modified trees or crops
- comes from areas where common law and civil rights are actively impeded
- comes from uncertified High Conservation Value Forests
- includes wood harvested from plantations established after 1994 through conversion of natural forests or converted to non-forest use
- comes from protected areas, in Sweden known as "key biotopes"
- has been harvested in ancient and/or endangered forests, nor endangered species habitats.

Dispensation may be granted from such restrictions, where the bio raw material derives from harvesting operations conducted as part of a biotope-conservation programme, in compliance with the official recommendations of the appropriate forestry/agriculture authority.

Control of origin

Domsjö Fiber AB strives to gain as complete a picture as possible of the original source of the bio raw material. Where there is reason to suspect that the bio raw material on offer may come from forests or agricultural land of the type described above, Domsjö Fiber AB shall seek to clarify the situation by contacting the appropriate authorities or by requiring a declaration of origin from the vendor/harvesting company. Should the declaration of origin submitted by a vendor be incorrect, Domsjö Fiber AB reserves the right to terminate the business agreement, whereby the vendor waives all rights to compensation.
